Handicap Information: Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)

Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) is the downward adjustment of individual hole scores for handicap purposes in order to make a Handicap Index more representative of a player's potential ability. ESC sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's <u>Course Handicap</u>. ESC is used only when a player's actual or most likely score <u>exceeds</u> the player's maximum number of strokes on any given hole. The table below shows the maximum number of strokes according to the player's course handicap. ESC is applied to all scores including tournament scores.

Course Handicap	Max. Number on any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or more	10
