## *From the Handicap Chair.....*

Definitions: Course Rating – The mark that indicates the evaluation of the playing difficulty of a course for a *scratch golfer* under normal conditions based on yardage and other obstacles that affect scoring ability. Slope Rating – The measurement of the relative difficulty of a course for players who are not scratch golfers. A golf course of standard playing difficulty has a Slope Rating of 113. *Peggy K.*

#### UNDERSTANDING THE RULES OF GOLF
