## SIM TOURNAMENT RESULTS

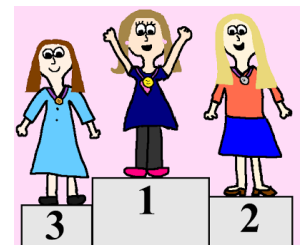

### HANDICAP INFORMATION

- Each time you receive a **Handicap Index** revision from KWGA, be sure to scroll all the way down the email to find your "printable card". Below that, you will see your **Course Handicap**, if it is not noted on the "card". If you belong to more than one club, your course handicap (for the courses your clubs play at) will be listed.
- Your **Handicap Index** (HI) is not your Course Handicap. Your Course Handicap is calculated using your HI and the Slope of the course you are playing. Therefore, you need to know your course handicap for the golf course you are playing in order to determine your Equitable Stroke Control (ESC). (Topic for next month's Newsletter.)
- What was formerly "Home Club" is now referred to as "Member Club". Often on a tournament entry form you are asked to include the name of your "Home Club". If you are a member of more than one club, you can select whichever one you choose to name as such.
- When you are entering scores in GHIN, you are to select either "Home" or "Away". When you played a course that is the course of one of your "Member Clubs", select **Home**. Select **Away** if you are playing at some other course.
- If you maintain both 9-hole and 18-hole GHIN numbers, you should be posting **all** of your golf scores in both places regardless of whether playing 9 holes or 18 holes.
- The Handicap Chairman will continue to post all BWGL Tournament scores. *Peggy King, Handicap Chair*
