NOTE: September 9th (18 holes) and September 12th (9 holes) are the only KWGA Low Net Play Days left.

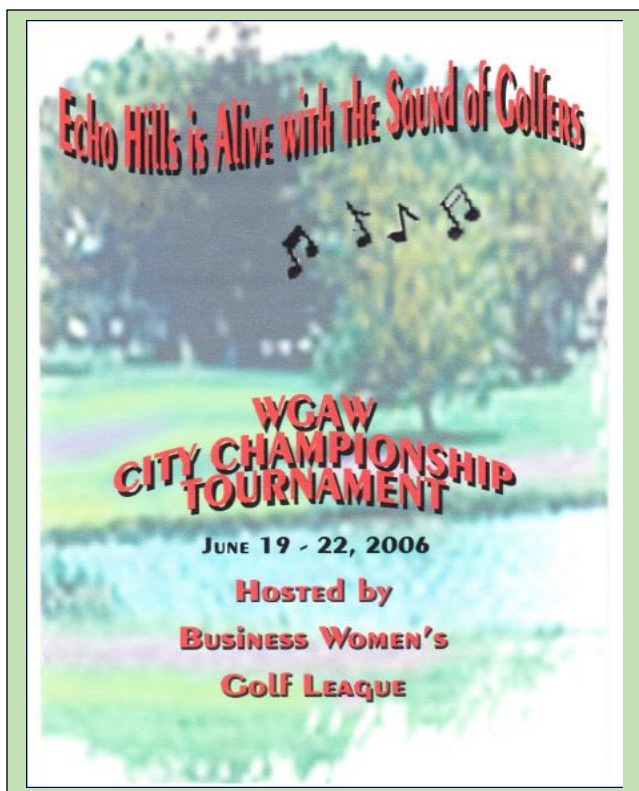
