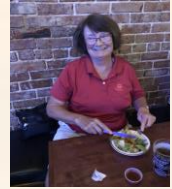

BWGL is On The Road Again To Hillcrest in Coffeyville

When we started out we had no idea how significant the words "tackling the course" was going to become! A little history of the course could shed some light on the challenges we faced. Hillcrest had its beginnings in the 1920's as a 9-hole sand green that was designed and owned by engineers from the National Refinery (now defunct). In 1932 the course was completely redesigned by Perry Maxwell who was known for his severely undulating greens and significant contours. Maxwell also designed Southern Hills in Tulsa and the first 9 holes at Prairie Dunes in Hutchinson. After 10 years or so the effects of the depression along with WW11 took its toll and Hillcrest Country Club went broke! In 1943 the course was sold to the City of Coffeyville for \$1! And for whatever reason, the mowers had gone "on the blink" before we got there.
